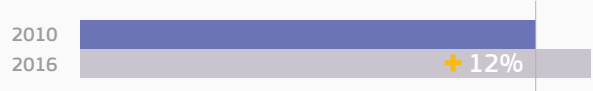

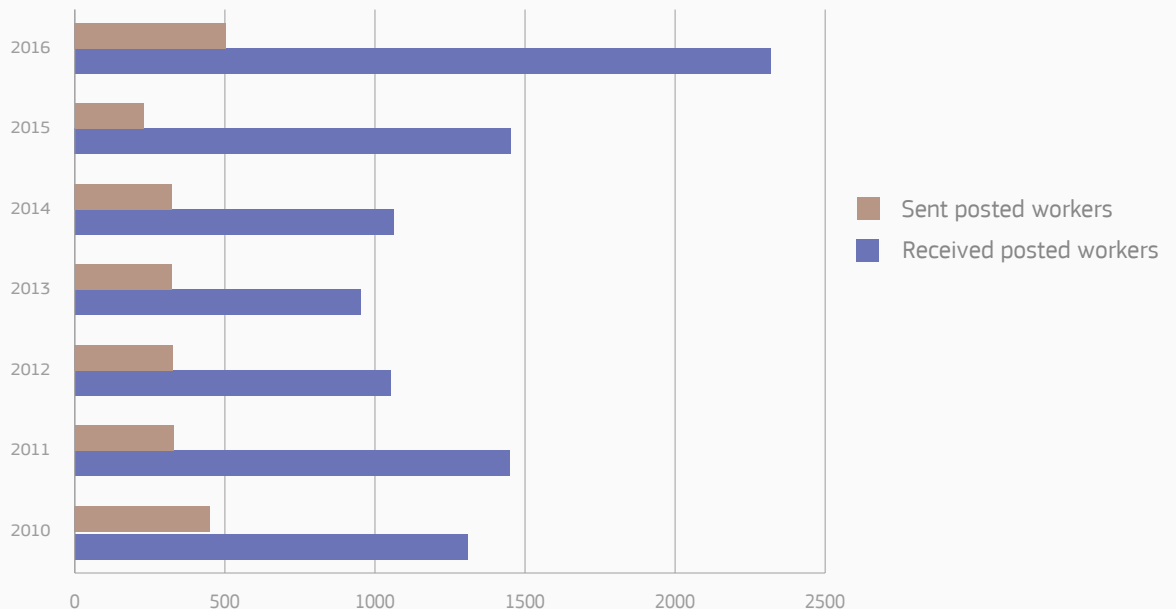

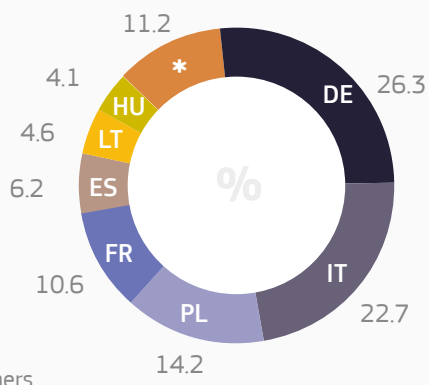

Trends on posting in Malta (2010-2016)

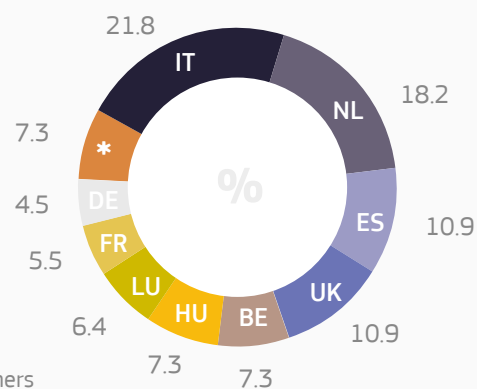


**Main origin of workers posted TO Malta in 2016 (%)**



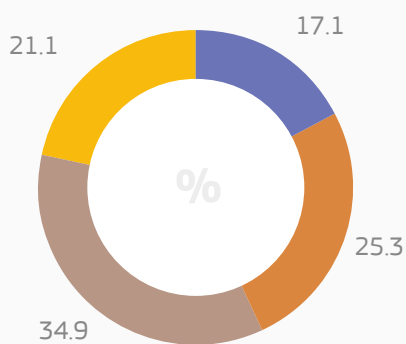

**Main destination of workers posted FROM Malta in 2016 (%)**



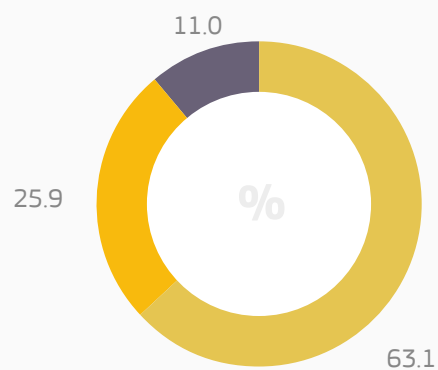
