2009 - 2011

- Government Resolution commitment to the adoption of EQF
- inter-ministerial working group for the implementation of SKKR
- National Coordination Point for EQF (NCP EQF)
- the first version of SKKR (8 levels)

Background - SKKR

2012 - 2015

- SKKR a part of the National Reform Programme
- Development of the National Qualifications Register
 (2013 15)
 - Analyses
 - Methodology for development of the NQF
 - revised SKKR (2014)
 - Methodology for linking qualifications to SKKR levels
 - Involvement of stakeholders (employers, experts, institutions, Sector Councils) on SKKR

2017

- Referencing report of the SKKR to EQF
 - Adoption of the Government SR

Background – Reforms/changes in education system

- 2008 **curricular reform** School Act (245/2008):
- shift to the learning outcomes approach performance standards quality assurance two-level model of curricula
 - 2013-15 National Qualifications Register:
 - qualifications standards
 - Sector Councils / employers involvement
 - 2015 elements of dual VET:
- involvement of employers and professional organisations in VET (content, QA, financing) – (Act 61/2015 on VET)

- HE - LO approach:

- Criteria for accreditation of study programmes of HE
- Decree of the education ministry on the credit system (614/2002)

Use of learning outcomes


 Qualifications standards (NQR) – definintion of LO from the EQF Recommendation (2009)

SKKR – NO distinction between qualifications from formal education (academic, initial vocational) and non-formal education and informal learning, comparing of learning outcomes

Education system in Slovakia

- New scheme highligting levels of qualifications
- All formal qualifications awarded on different levels of the system

- Discussions and consultations of Ministry of Education, stakeholders, experts
- Produced within the referencing process in Slovakia





SLOVAK QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK – SKKR

Roles of SKKR

- Communication
- Transformation
 - Regulatory

- SKKR classification of qualifications
- hierarchical levels by a certain level of difficulty
- reference characteristics national descriptors





Subframeworks of SKKR

- General education qualifications' sub-framework
- Vocational qualifications' subframework
- HE qualifications' sub-framework

- Occupational qualifications' subframework
 - = a link between the sub-frameworks in the LLL perspective







SKKR vs. EQF

Level descriptors - hierarchical principle

Frame- work	Categories		
EQF	Knowledge	Skills	Competences
SKKR	Knowledge: general vocational	Skills: cognitive practical	Responsibility and autonomy Social competences

- Semantic analysis of LO requirements vs. descriptors at particular level
 - Methodologies based on "best-fit" principle
 - Approval by competent authorities

SKKR descriptors

"horizontal and vertical reading" (increase of LOs requirements)

- complexity, scope and deepness of <u>knowledge</u> and their <u>understanding</u>;
- degree of necessary <u>support</u> for performing activities or during learning;
- degree of required integration, independency and creativity;
- range and complexity of application of knowledge or practice;
- degree of <u>transparency and dynamics</u> of situations within the practice or during learning

Future of SKKR

- Comprehensive reform of the education system in the Slovak Republic
- Further development of the national qualifications system
- Act on Quality Assurance in Higher Education (2018)
- Ammendments of LLL Act (2018)
- Introduction of the **EQF/SKKR level** on all documents on qualifications
- Introduction of the system of validation of VNIL
