- f) the shift towards learning outcomes-based qualifications;
- g) a credit structure and units as building blocks of qualifications;
- h) the concept of mutual trust through quality assurance mechanisms that cut across all levels of the framework.

Qualifications	Awards
An individual has achieved learning outcomes to the standards in terms of level descriptors on the MQF and a number of credits as specified in the Referencing Report.	Refers to the title of certification of learning achieved through courses which do not have the required number of credits at the specific MQF Level to be a considered as a Qualification.
A qualification is the formal outcome of an assessment and validation process.
























Recognition

- The criteria used for the recognition of qualifications include the following:
 - education system in the given country;
 - status of awarding body and programmes of studies;
 - access requirements; study workload; learning outcomes;
 - level on the National Qualification Framework (NQF);
 - takes into account previous recognition practices of similar qualifications.







Awarding Institution:

The Awarding Institution is the Institute that confers the qualification or award whose name would appear on a certificate issued by it. Institute must be recognized by an ENIC NARIC or similar. Recognition does not imply that all PoSs issued by it are also recognized.

The **Awarding Institution** and the **Training Provider**, where the programme of studies was undertaken might be different, but research is based on the conferring body, i.e. the Awarding Institution.











Self Accrediting Institution:

The Further and Higher Education (Licensing, Accreditation and Quality Assurance) Regulations S.L. 327.433, allows for self-accrediting providers, meaning designated institutions have the capacity to self-accredit existing and new programmes and are exempt from provider and programme accreditation for the purposes of these regulations. Recognition by MQRIC is not necessary within Maltese jurisdiction.















MQRIC's duty is to assess whether PoS is recognised, but <u>NOT to authenticate the document</u>. This responsibility of employers or other entities who wish to have a relationship with holder of such certificates/documents.










Step 6: If your qualification is present on the database after pressing "Add", the above is displayed.


