Five parallel visits to four different organisations. Delegates will be split into five groups according to their preferences and project capacity. Each group will visit one project.

1. **'Food aid on wheels' – FEAD in rural areas** (French Red Cross) – *visit to the headquarters to see the food distribution truck*
2. **Job opportunities at a FEAD food aid depot** (Les Restaurants du Cœur) – *visit to the depot to learn about the opportunities it offers*
3. **Gateway to social inclusion through food aid** (Les Restaurants du Cœur) – *visit to a food distribution centre offering a range of accompanying measures*
4. **The food aid distribution cycle of the Paris Food Bank** (FFBA) – *visit to the Paris Food Bank to see the distribution cycle*
5. **Diverse assistance including FEAD at the Paris Departmental Federation** (Secours populaire français) – *visit to the Paris Departmental Federation to see a diverse range of services*

Buses will take each group to the respective project sites from Novotel at 9.15 and then bring them to the French Managing Authority's venue between 11.30 and 12.00 for the closing session which will be held there.
