Summary of the action

The proposed project provides three main categories of interventions:

The first category of interventions includes two distinct actions: a. (WP1) The mapping, identification and prioritization of potential target groups in need of upskilling interventions for further actions beyond the project's pilot upskilling activity as well; b.(WP2) The identification-mapping of the available upskilling pathways and opportunities in Greece focused on low qualified/skilled adults pursuing a skills upgrade towards EQF levels 3 and/or 4. In this framework there will be a thorough review of the pathways within the three dimensions of education and training (formal, informal and non-formal) focusing in literacy, numeracy and digital skills.

The second category of interventions includes three distinct actions: a. (WP3) An extensive exploration and review of relevant assessment tools and practices at national, European and international levels and subsequently the development of an appropriate assessment tool for our case (pilot intervention);b. (WP4) The mapping and reviewing of adult upskilling learning/teaching theories and effective methodologies in order also to adequately prepare relevant pedagogic approaches for the pilot activity c.(WP5) The Tailored Pilot Intervention which is expected to be catalyst for determining and finally proposing the most suitable assessment and pedagogic methodology for the target group.

The third category of interventions (WP6) includes various dissemination actions (conferences, workshops and digital material) conducted by the applicant and the co-applicants in order to provide coherent information to priority groups and to raise awareness as well as mobilize all the relevant actors in adult education for taking action on the upskilling field by suggesting targeted policies towards Council's Recommendation on "Upskilling Pathways" and designing-delivering tailored measures to reach out to specific priority groups.

Summary of the action

The E.QU.A.L. action will contribute to preparing the ground for the effective implementation of the Upskilling Pathways Recommendation in Italy by providing a concrete contribution in the identification of the main elements of an UP strategy. It will do so by mapping existing policies, tools, and resources following the three-step approach envisaged by the Recommendation (skills assessment, personalised training and skills validation); developing a methodology for the identification of priority groups that can be customised to the needs of the different regional contexts; developing a model for the implementation of the UP building on existing practices. It will work in close cooperation with relevant actors in the field of adult learning and main bodies in charge of the UP strategy in order to ensure that activities and outputs are tailored to their information needs and their awareness is raised.
