

GENDER EMPLOYMENT GAP (20-64)




EMPLOYMENT OLDER WORKERS (55-64)

*Young people not in employment, education or training




UNEMPLOYMENT (15-74)

YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT (15-24)




AT RISK OF POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION (% of population)




INCOME INEQUALITY


(Ratio of incomes of richest 20% of households to poorest 20%)

UNMET MEDICAL NEEDS (% of population)




IMPACT OF SOCIAL TRANSFERS ON POVERTY

(Reduction of risk of poverty rate due to social transfers)




HOUSEHOLD INCOME INDEX (2008=100)
