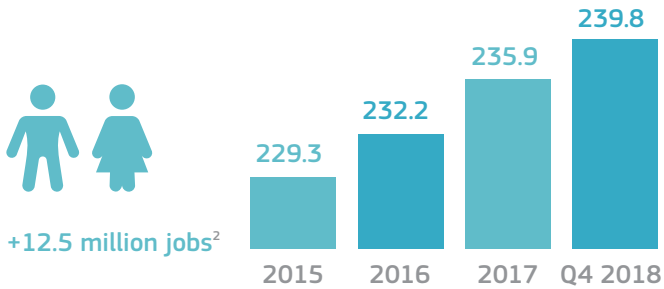

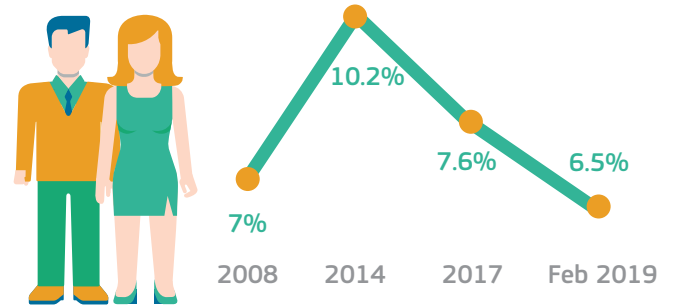
EU EMPLOYMENT LEVEL (IN MILLIONS)¹



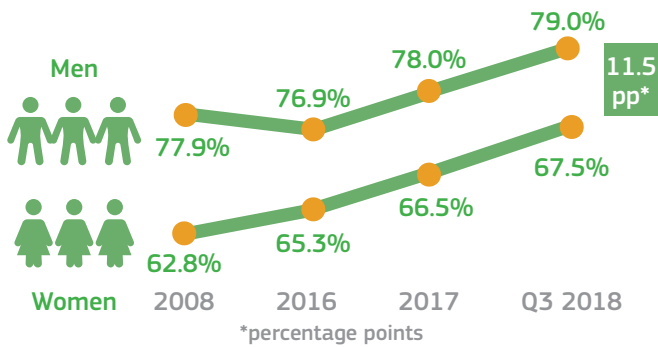

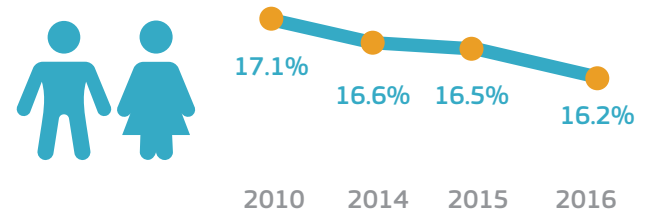
UNEMPLOYMENT (15-74)



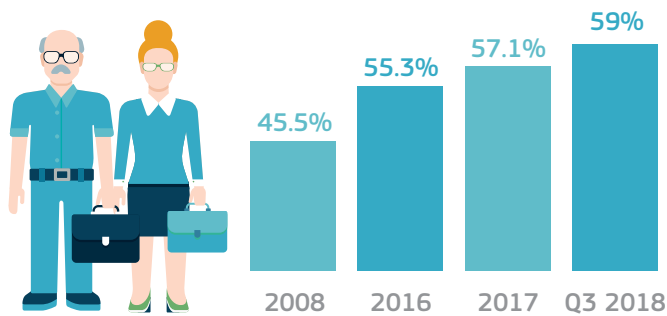
GENDER EMPLOYMENT GAP (20-64)



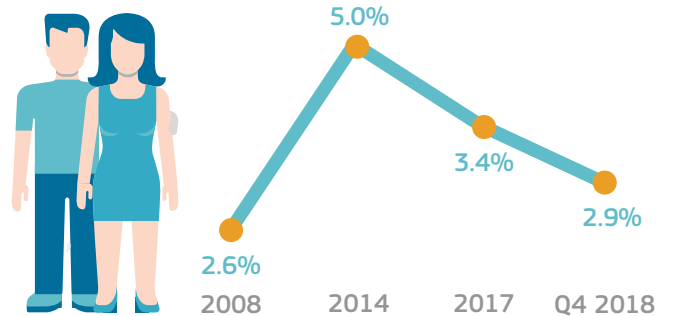
GENDER PAY GAP



EMPLOYMENT OLDER WORKERS (55-64)

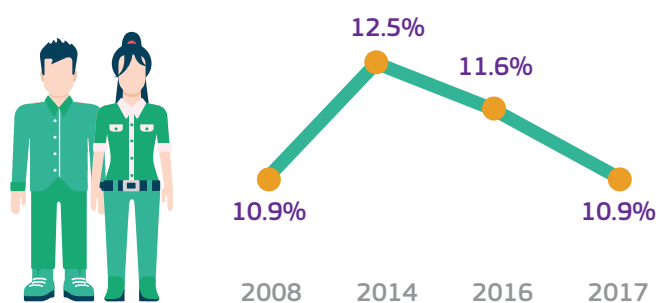

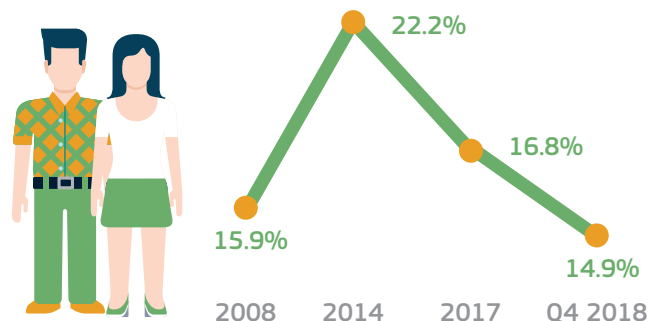


NEET* (% of total population aged 15-24)

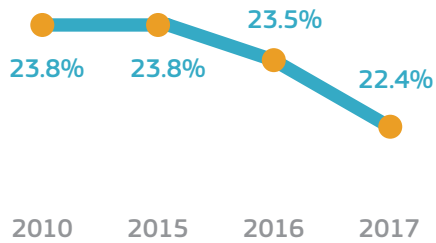

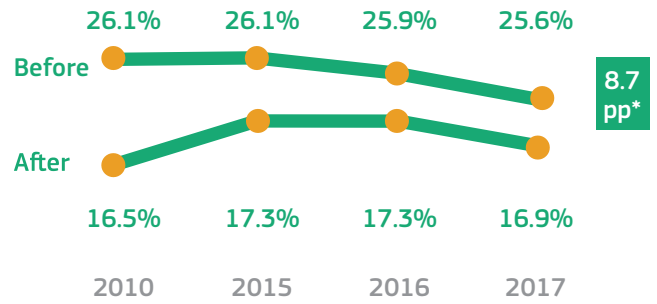
YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT (15-24)



AT RISK OF POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION (% of population)



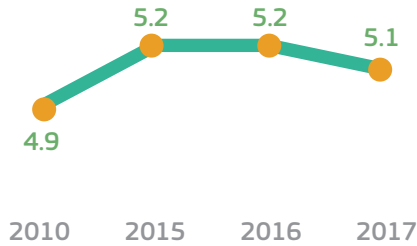
IMPACT OF SOCIAL TRANSFERS ON POVERTY (Reduction of risk of poverty rate due to social transfers)



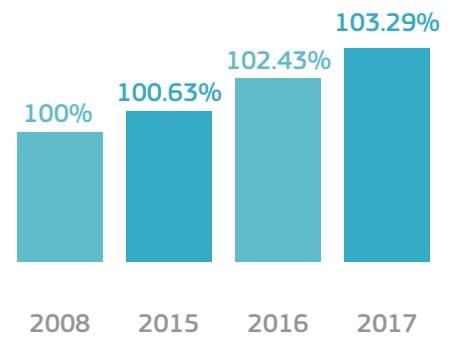

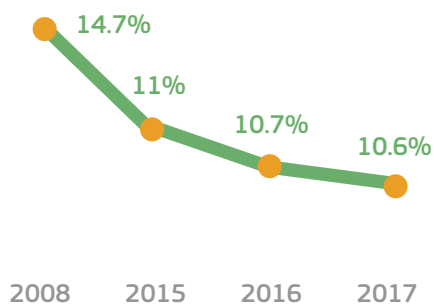
INCOME INEQUALITY (Ratio of incomes of richest 20% of households to poorest 20%)



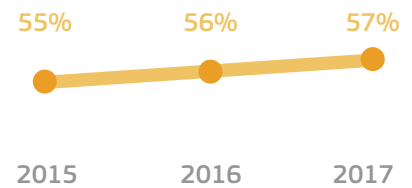
HOUSEHOLD INCOME INDEX (2008=100)



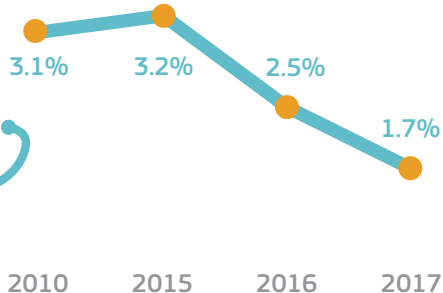
EARLY SCHOOL LEAVERS (18-24)
