Summary of the action

An executive summary of the grant application VP 2018/007/0004 is annexed to this application form.

Work package 1 will improve the progress of the mainstreaming of Eures within the PES. We aim to improve flagging and tracking as much as possible through mitigating measures included in work packages 12,13,14

Work package 2 will focus on groups of job seekers who will find employment directly after the training and/or increase their skill set and knowledge of cross border working.

Work package 3 provides valuable advisory and career counselling services through the network of trade union Eures advisors who on the whole are at the forefront of disadvantageous situations for workers e.g. relocations and/or reorganisations involving redundancy.

Work packages 4,9,10 focus on targeted networking with employers and HR professionals with cross border recruitment needs. Improving the mind set of employers towards a wider catchment area and increasing the level of vacancies flagged with cross border interest will lead to more matching activities. This combined with work package 7 should lead to direct placements with employers.

The provision of an online matchings app through work package 5 will give HR professionals and employers easy access to available HR resources on the cross border labour market. The action is targeted to at least 200 Dutch & 200 Belgian employers/entrepreneurs online profiles.

Work package 6 aims to reduce legislative obstacles and financial worries amongst highly motivated job seekers supporting their transition from benefit to work.

Work package 7 will provide a skills supply-oriented service for employers in the cross border region.

Work package 8 in general will focus on mapping out the state of affairs in the technical professions.

Work package 11 will provide a contribution to 'fair mobility' in practice and sustainable employment in the long term.

Summary of the action

Die Grenzpartnerschaft EURES-TriRegio setzt sich aus Vertretern der Arbeitsverwaltungen, der Gewerkschaften und der Arbeitgeberorganisationen aus Sachsen, Böhmen und Niederschlesien zusammen. Ihr langfristiges Ziel ist es, unter Einhaltung der bestehenden Arbeits- und Sozialstandards des jeweiligen Landes die Entwicklung eines gemeinsamen Arbeitsmarktes zu fördern.

Sie wurde von den Partnern seit der Integration Polens und Tschechiens in die Europäische Union im Jahre 2004 vorbereitet und hat sich mit der Unterzeichnung der Rahmenvereinbarung im Oktober 2007 konstituiert. Sie betrachtet die Integration der Arbeits- und Ausbildungsmärkte im Dreiländereck als die wesentliche Gestaltungsaufgabe. Zu den Handlungsschwerpunkten gehören: Projekte zur Vermittlung von Arbeitsstellen in der Region; Information und Beratung durch die EURES-Beraterinnen und -Berater und Initiativen zur Durchsetzung von fairer Mobilität im Dreiländereck.

Die Angebote für Arbeitgeber richten sich insbesondere an kleine und mittlere Unternehmen. Es werden Unterstützungsleistungen zur Rekrutierung angeboten, wie online- und onsite Jobbörsen, Stände bei Jobbörsen, Informations- und Beratungstage bis hin zu individuellen Vermittlungsprojekten für Unternehmen bei Neuansiedlungen. Die Arbeitgeber profitieren von einem gewachsenen Netzwerk der EURES-Beraterinnen und -Berater bei der Arbeitsverwaltung, das über eine umfassende Erfahrung bei der Durchführung grenzüberschreitender Vermittlungsprojekte verfügt.

Arbeitssuchende erhalten Hilfe bei der Arbeitssuche im Grenzraum. Es werden Informationen und Beratungen für Grenzgänger bereitgestellt. Die Beratung für Arbeitnehmer erfolgt unter Zusammenarbeit mit den Branchengewerkschaften, Sozialversicherungsträgern und anderen Beratungseinrichtungen. Die Anfragen von Grenzgängern zu Fragen der sozialen und arbeitsrechtlichen Absicherung nehmen Jahr von Jahr zu.

Summary of the action

Im Rahmen dieser Maßnahme wird eine EU-Finanzierung für die euregionale und bilaterale Zusammenarbeit in den Grenzregionen der Länder Belgien, Deutschland, Niederlande beantragt, die die bestehenden Dienstleistungen der Partner optimiert und stärkt sowie diese über das bisherige Maß hinaus koordiniert und ausbaut, in dem weitere neue innovative Maßnahmen passgerecht hinzugefügt werden.

EMR, ERW, ermn, EUREGIO: Die Maßnahme beinhaltet alle Aktivitäten der Partner im angegebenen Zeitraum. Ziel ist es, die Transparenz des grenzüberschreitenden Arbeitsmarktes zu fördern, die Chancen der Arbeitssuchenden auf dem Markt zu erhöhen und die Arbeitgeber bei ihren Einstellungsmaßnahmen zu unterstützen. Gegenstand sind die Serviceangebote der Partner in Bezug auf das grenzüberschreitende Matching, Information und Beratung der mobilen Arbeitssuchenden, Grenzgänger und Unternehmen im Bezirk der Euregios.

Zentrales Ziel der Maßnahme ist es "Menschen in ein Beschäftigungsverhältnis zu bringen und Arbeitsplätze zu sichern" und so einen Beitrag zu mehr Beschäftigung zu leisten. So sollen die Transparenz des euregionalen Arbeitsmarktes gefördert werden, die Nachfrage und das Angebot optimal aufeinander abgestimmt werden und Mobilitätshemmnisse durch eine breiter angelegte Zusammenarbeit mit den Institutionen, die für Steuern, soziale Sicherheit und Arbeitsrecht zuständig sind, gemindert werden. Außerdem geht es darum:

- die Zusammenarbeit mit anderen Organisationen in Belangen des Arbeitsmarktes zu optimieren, insbesondere mit den für Sozialversicherung, Steuern und Arbeitsrecht zuständigen Stellen
- die Zielgruppen über die Serviceangebote zu informieren
- das Personalwesen und das Netzwerk der EURES-Partner zu erweitern
- die Ergebnisse des Arbeitsplans nachzuhalten, zu evaluieren und zu bewerten.

Die Partnerschaft ist übereingekommen, alle vorgegebenen zehn Arbeitsbereiche bzw. Kategorien zu bedienen und entsprechende Maßnahmen zu planen und umzusetzen (siehe Anhang).

Summary of the action

The grant application includes activities under the following categories of 1, 2, 4, 5, 8. The overall aim for all activities is to promote geographical and occupational labour mobility in the EEA countries on a voluntary and fair basis, as well as organise the work of EURES in own country in line with the requirements, standards and procedures established in the EURES regulation and the EURES implementing decisions. The European added value is distinct in all the activities.

The activities aim to be concrete, action oriented and carry a clear added value in terms of making a difference where rolled out. This entail that the activities are adjusted according to demands in the labour markets. Thus the service becomes relevant and innovative. Moreover, the activities will aim to pay particular attention to vulnerable groups, promote equality between men and women, combat any kind of discrimination and promote a high-level of quality and sustainable employment. Focus will be to ensure a transparent labour market with exchange of job vacancies, CVs (jobseeker profile's) in accordance with the uniform system for the EURES portal and any related information, as well as provide free support services for the recruitment and placement of workers in employment.

More concretely the activities will encompass:

- Meetings at EU Level covering different topics
- Meetings, seminars, ad-hoc working Groups, a training and a conference at national Level
- Meetings with NCOs and EURES Members/Partners in other countries
- Job fairs, seminars and meetings with employers and jobseekers
- Translation, advertisement

This to ensure increased visibility and awareness of EURES and as a long-term impact a better functioning labour market for the best of EEA citizens. Activities are linked to the defined indicators described in the Performance Measurement System. Thanks to these, concrete results of implementing the activities will be visible.

Summary of the action

We will conduct an analysis of the current labour market and its future potential in the Øresund region in cooperation with Øresundsinstittet.

We will be continuing the project regarding the young jobseekers (YJ) to hotel and retail with minor adjustments. The project will consist of a tailored training course; thereafter the participants will be matched and placed with private companies within the service sector and through a facebook group.

The project concerning the construction sector PES will match and place craftsmen, construction advisors and other academics with construction companies, with a big focus on assisting Anglophone jobseekers within the field. Moreover, there will be 2 construction trade council meetings.

We will also continue the Life Science (LS) project, visiting job fairs in Europe and use social media. We will reach out to unemployed regional LS specialists, YJ, Students and new graduates in the region to promote regional job search and matching.

The fourth project concerns Danish academics to Sweden. The job seeking academics in Greater Copenhagen will receive a tailored course, which will prepare them for academic job vacancies in Scania. PES in Denmark will be responsible for managing the tailored courses, which will be developed in cooperation with Swedish PES. Swedish PES will be responsible for contact to employers in Scania, moreover matching and placing participants.

The fifth project will be targeting jobseekers who are 55 years old and above. This project will target jobseekers equally on either side of the border. The participating jobseekers will receive a crash course in seeking jobs on the opposite side of the border. PES on either side of the border is responsible for informing about matching and placement events.

In the last project Øresunddirekt we will further develop the income calculator and a digital job guide.

Summary of the action

The creation of the EURES Crossborder North Portugal - Galicia service in December 1997 followed the common objective and commitment of the partner bodies towards improving the situation of the labour market of Galicia and North Portugal, creating a transparent employment market and developing a system of cooperation and collaboration between the public employment services and all other economic and social agents representing the Euro-region with potential ability to facilitate and boost the crossborder mobility of workers and employers.

EURES Crossborder Galicia-North Portugal has become a reference structure in the Euro-region. Moreover, it operates as a meeting point for entities and institutions concerning mobility.

The bodies included in the structure of EURES Crossborder Galicia-North Portugal have undertaken among one another and before the Commission to jointly pursue the following objectives based on EURES Regulation (EU) 2016/589 and the EU rules on the freedom to work and look for a job in another EU Member State (Regulation EU 492/2011), in conformity with their responsibilities at a crossborder level:

- implementing the coordinated strategy for employment and, in particular, for promoting a skilled, trained and adaptable workforce as referred to in Article 145 TFEU;
- improving the functioning, cohesion and integration of the labour markets in the Union, including at cross-border level;
- promoting voluntary geographical and occupational mobility in the Union, including in cross-border regions, on a fair basis and in compliance with Union and national law and practice;
- supporting transitions into the labour market, thereby promoting the social and employment objectives referred to in Article 3 TEU.

For the pursuit of the established general objectives, the bodies integrated in the structure undertake will provide specific Services according to the competencies of each of them.

Summary of the action

Summary of the action

The main objective of the action is to remain pragmatic in our approach and to ask ourselves regarding each work package how we can make the most of our limited resources (financial and human) of EURES combined with tools and resources available to us by PES. Work packages address mainly jobseekers and employers and are meant to support those two groups in different ways.

Our service is mainly focused on direct matching and placements rather than on information delivery which was our main focus a few years ago. EURES IS implemented reformed overall work procedures in 2017 and this will impact the 2019 plan also since we are still working on projects especially in relation to IT matters. We have a growing customer base of employers, many of whom return to us annually for vacancy handling and recruitment of employees. We will continue servicing these customers but we will also reach out to targeted employers that we believe could benefit from the service of EURES and are in need of employees. Our focus will be on domestic employers. Domestic jobseekers as well as foreign will also remain a target group. By providing quality service to employers we enhance options for jobseekers. EURES IS focuses on a well structured and user friendly online service. With full adaptation of EURES to the PES website and PES online service we have more options in IT and with an active Facebook profile we raise awareness to new potential clients, jobseekers and employers alike. EURES IS is well intergrated into PES but to maintain that status we will continue with information sessions and awareness raising among colleagues.

Our unit consists of three EURES employees and in 2017 we also launched a project with PES where PES counselors in the rural districts have been given the role of active EURES assistants. That program will continue to develop in 2019 and the assistants will become an even more important part of the EURES IS structure and service.

Summary of the action

The ETUC coordinates the participation of the trade union organizations in the EURES network. Up to now it is mostly the Interregional Trade Union Councils (IRTUCs), at regional/interregional levels, who are participating.

The IRTUCs gather in border regions regional trade union organizations which are part of ETUC member organizations. The main objective of the IRTUCs is to ensure fair and chosen mobility of EU citizens and workers and to defend the rights of frontier workers and their families.

IRTUCs are partners of the EURES Cross Border Partnerships. About 60 EURES trade union advisers (who have followed the EURES basic training) are giving advice and councils to cross border and frontier workers. This is the specific role of trade unions in the EURES Network. Trade unions do not deal with placements and recruitments. In some Member States this is actually considered illegal.

This project will deliver three European events involving participants from all over the EU (a seminar of EURES Trade union advisers, a seminar of the EURES Cross-border Partnerships, and a seminar on taxation), all of which will help strengthening the involvement not only of trade unions but also of employers and public employment services (local employment services, national EURES managers).

All of these actions will allow ETUC to:

- contribute to the implementation of the EURES Regulation;
- improve the quality of the EURES services provided by trade union organizations directly involved as EURES members or partners;
- identify and contribute to the suppression of the obstacles to mobility;
- ensure/strengthen the functioning of the EURES Cross Border Partnerships;
- improve practical cooperation between employers' and workers' organizations at regional, interregional and national level as regards labour mobility;
- develop the networking between the partners;
- improve the visibility of EURES.
