On 17 November 2017, the leaders of the European Union solemnly proclaimed the European Pillar of Social Rights at the Social Summit for fair jobs and growth in Gothenburg, Sweden.

The European Pillar of Social Rights is about delivering **new and more effective rights for citizens**. It expresses 20 principles and rights essential for fair and well-functioning labour markets and welfare systems in 21<sup>st</sup> century Europe.

Since then, the European Commission has taken concrete initiatives to put the 20 rights and principles of the Pillar into practice at European level. And by working together with the European Parliament, Member States, social partners and civil society, it has the potential to improve significantly the social situation of millions of Europeans by investing in their future.
