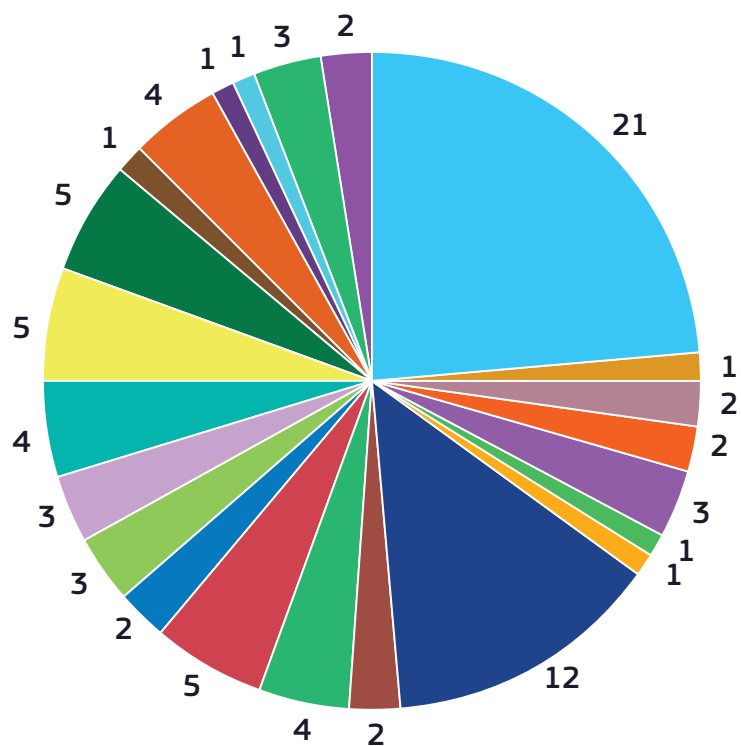

DELEGATE BREAKDOWN BY COUNTRY

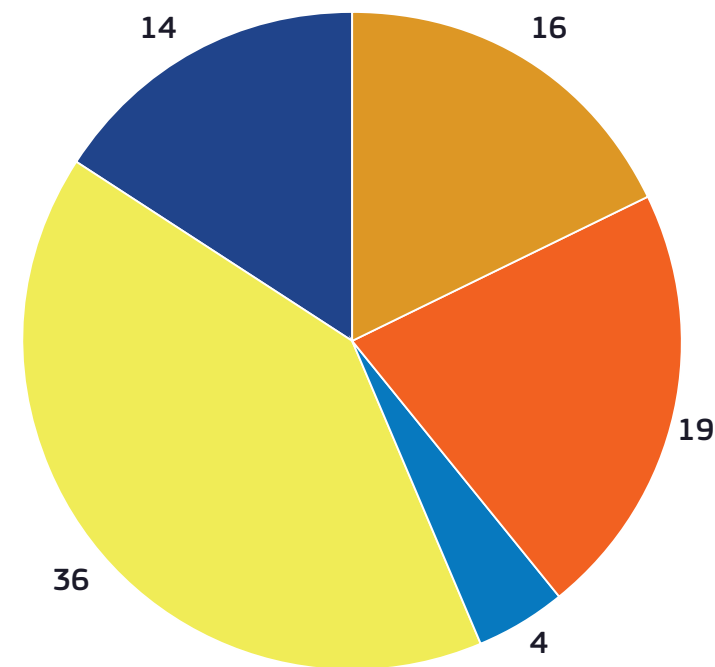

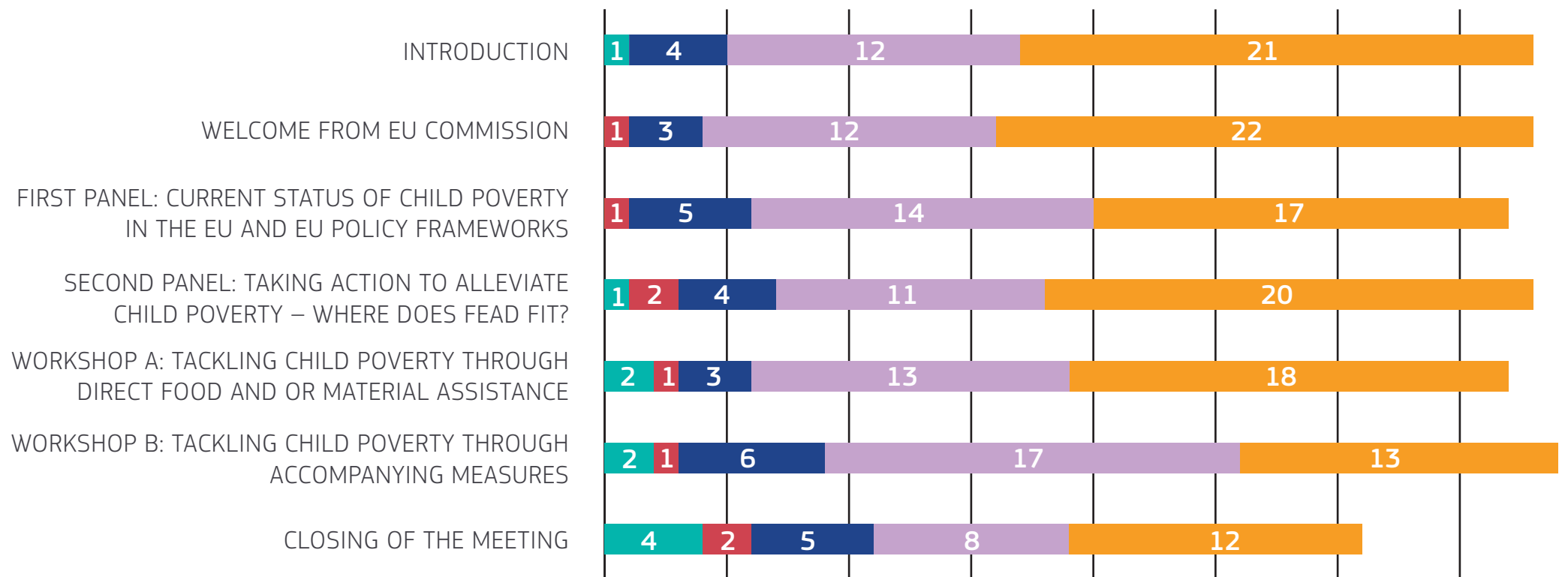

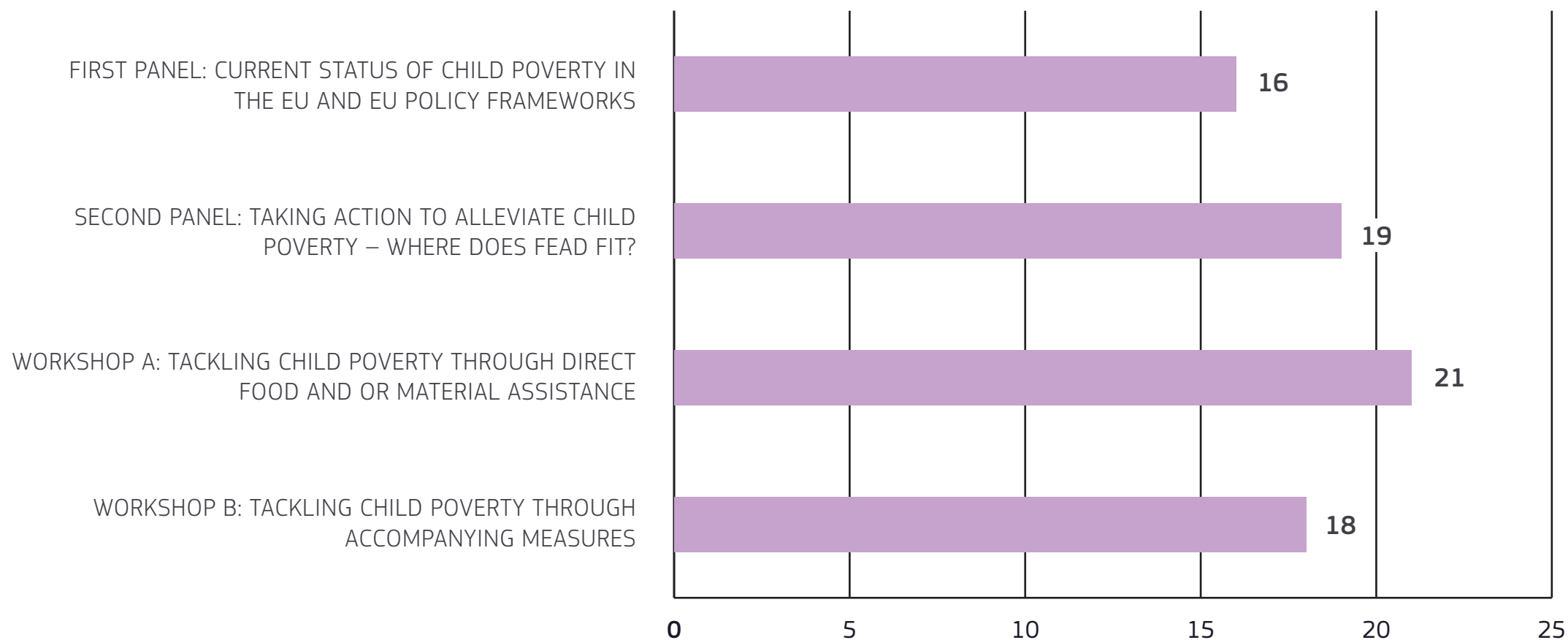

KEY LEARNING



Child poverty in EU policy making:

- Child poverty is gaining status in EU policy making.
- FEAD is a stepping-stone, not an end in itself.
- FEAD is the first step towards social inclusion and can provide access to social rights for children



The role of FEAD in tackling child poverty:

- Material assistance is essential as an entry point for vulnerable people to long-term targeted assistance.
- Overcome limited funding for accompanying measures by setting up partnerships with other entities or seek other funding sources
- Integrated services are key to tackle poverty
- Stimulate collaboration to empower vulnerable families
