
01. OGMA & IEFP Background

Aiming to improve the company's performance and the capacity to keep up with its evolution, OGMA and IEFP established a partnership in 2015 by training young and long term unemployed professionals in aircraft production and maintenance.

By supporting these professionals OGMA suppressed the current market resources scarcity and helped us tackle a part of the medium and long term skilled labor needs.

The focus on development, qualification and certification is fundamental to business growth. A solid process of management is critical to ensure the attraction, retention and development of our employees to keep up with the business needs, due to:

- · Rapidly aging organization;
- Lack of market response capacity (lack of labour);
- 2 to 5 training years of Aeronautics Maintenance Technitians;
- Business growth is greater than the technitians and mechanics training capacity.

OGMA also organizes other types of internship programs:

- <u>High school students</u>: through the local "Gago Coutinho Secondary School", where the company provides trainers and hosts 11° year and 12° year internships for students of the Industrial Maintenance/Aeronautics professional course;
- <u>Graduate Training Programe</u>: through the Trainee Program, where the company hosts an yearly program during which 10/15 Trainees develop a strategic project within the organization.
