New Approach Needs Modern Methods

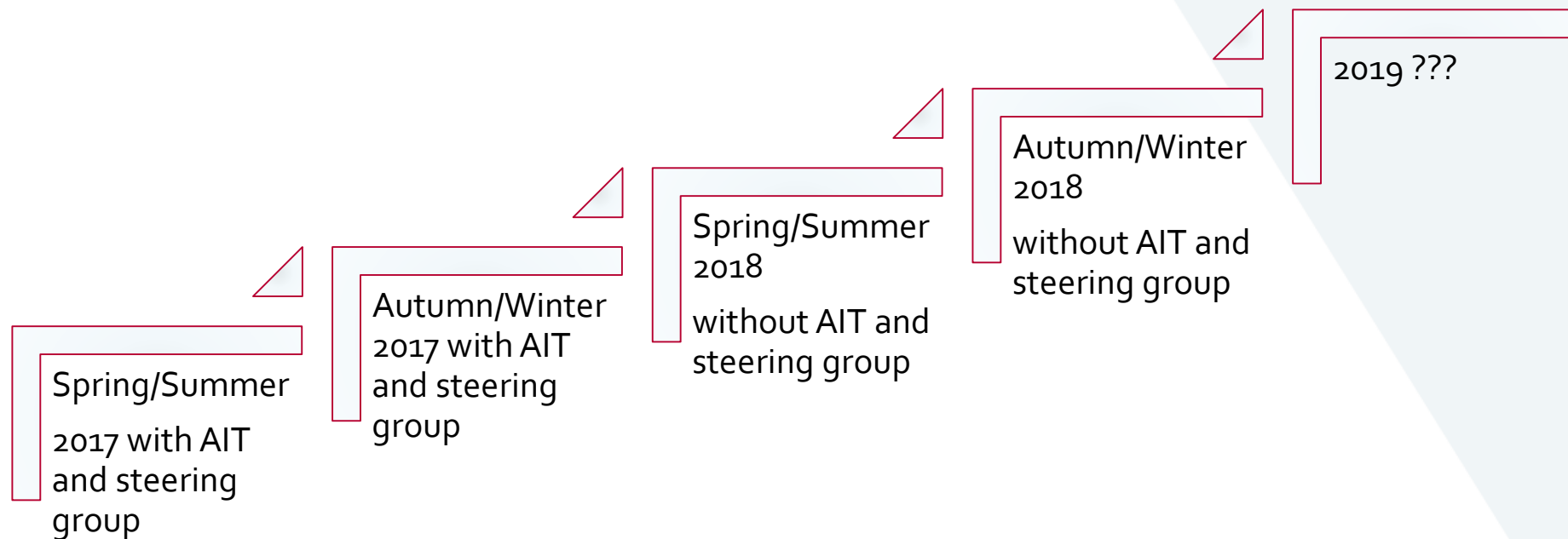
Developing creative, innovative ideas through new information, organisational and communication technologies, such as:
