

The Service takes appropriate measures to ensure adequate employment of unemployed and unemployed citizens in the legislation of the Republic of Azerbaijan, involvement in paid public works, vocational training and supplementary education, in accordance with the legislation, the allocation, and payment of unemployment benefits. Ensure that employment is provided to citizens who are in need of social protection at the expense of job opportunities identified and who have difficulty finding employment.



Preference is given to youth employment, vocational training based on real labor market requirements, involvement in paid social work, and self-employment.

As a result of the progress made in the creation of the Youth Employment Network, the UN Secretary-General, Mr. Koffi Annan, has been declared by the UN General Assembly as one of the top ten states in terms of youth employment.





Vocational work is a system of social and pedagogical measures aimed at preparing young people for the choice of profession, their acquisition of professional skills and their employment, taking into account their interests and tendencies, labor market demand. To increase the efficiency of the profession, for the first time since 2008, professional events have been held in Baku with the participation of senior students, as well as their parents. During the first 10 months of 2019, 89,014 people were involved in career counseling, of which 81% were young people.





The Employment subsystem created in the centralized electronic information system of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection will provide an opportunity to apply for active employment projects of the State Employment Service under the Ministry. It will be possible to access and use employment services in real-time through the subsystem, which reflects a realistic view of vacancies, unemployed and job seekers and is constantly updated.





The Employment subsystem also has a constantly updated database reflecting the real picture of unemployed and job seekers, and this database is constantly updated. The Employment subsystem also provides an opportunity for employers to find a suitable candidate within a short period of time without losing time on their vacancies and, consequently, to meet employers' workforce demands for certain professions and specialties. Delivery of vacancies to the vacancies is carried out on the electronic infrastructure, which eliminates the loss of time in employment and employee recruitment, providing a modern working style, transparency and a direct control mechanism in the area.



The State Employment Service at the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Population is cooperating with vocational training on the request of employers to train new staff and further improve their employees' professional skills. Over the past period of the year, 1754 unemployed and unemployed people were involved in vocational training courses, of which 678 are young people.







The first step in an active employment event, called First Step in Careers, is for students and alumni to make initial contact with their employers and employers to choose the workforce they will need in the future. In the current year, more than 7 universities have been actively involved in "First step in career".
