Building on pilot project SOLiD I.

- 3 years programme (2016-2019), with a €3.750 million budget (80% EU and 20% International Trade Union Confederation).
- Consortium which consists of 9 members: ATUC
 (Arab Trade Union Confederation), BusinessMed
 (Union of Mediterranean Confederation of
 Enterprises), ANND (Arab NGO Network for
 Development), ISCOS (Italian Union Institute for
 Cooperation and Development), Progetto SUD,
 AIP (Portugal Industry Association), SOLIDAR,
 CNT Belgium (National Labor Council) and CES
 Morocco (Economic and Social Council).



SOLID I.

- 3 countries (Jordan, Morroco, Tunisia)
- Results:
 - A better understanding of the economic and social situation in the targeted countries and of the mechanisms of social dialogue including civil society
 - An enhanced exchange and a mutual learning of the relevant stakeholders on regional level
 - Promoted policies for social dialogue and exchange of best practices, in the region, and further developed at EU-Southern Mediterranean level.

UfM Ministerial conference in Cascais

 Declaration of the Ministerial conference reiterated "the crucial role, at all pertinent levels, of an effective and on-going social dialogue, (...) to help addressing the challenges of growth, democracy and social justice in the region". Ministers called on national authorities to adopt strategies to, among others, promote a wellfunctioning social dialogue, at all pertinent levels, including the involvement of social partners in the design, implementation and monitoring of economic and social policies.



NEAR regional Action Plan 2019

- Promotion of social dialogue in the Southern Mediterranean Neighbourhood – SOLiD II
- financed under the European Neighbourhood
 Instrument
- EUR 7 million
- Component 1: Inclusive and structured social dialogue (€3 millions)
- Component 2: Social dialogue to bridge the employability gap (€4 millions)



Component 1 – Inclusive and structured social dialogue SOLiD II.

- Implemented as a follow up to the SOLiD I.
- Direct award to consortium led by ITUC
- Translating the Charter into concrete actions in the 3 countries (Jordan, Morroco, Tunisia)
- Expanding the work into new 3 countries (Algeria, Lebanon and Palestine)



Component 2 - Social dialogue to bridge the employability gap

- Indirect management to ILO
- Focus on employability issues and transition from informal to formal economy
- Support to policy framework
- Fostering skills development



Component 2 - Social dialogue to bridge the employability gap

• The target groups are representative national employers and workers' organisations, Ministries of Labour and other concerned ministries, tripartite social dialogue institutions and representative membership-based organisations in the informal economy in the target countries, as well as vocational training institutions.



Component 2 - Social dialogue to bridge the employability gap

• The ultimate beneficiaries of component 2 are workers and economic units in the informal economy, with a focus on youth and women.

Promotion of Social Dialogue in the Southern Mediterranean Neighbourhood

 The indicative operational implementation period of the action, during which activities of both components will be carried is 72 months.
