



Millions of people, 'compared to Q4-2019


EMPLOYMENT RATE (20-64)




GENDER EMPLOYMENT GAP (20-64)



YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (15-24)




UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (15-74)

EMPLOYMENT RATE OLDER WORKERS (55-64)




NEET* (% of total population aged 15-24) *Young people not in employment, education or training

INCOME INEQUALITY


(Ratio of incomes of richest 20% of households to poorest 20%)




EARLY SCHOOL LEAVERS (18-24)




SELF-REPORTED UNMET MEDICAL NEEDS (% of population)



IMPACT OF SOCIAL TRANSFERS ON POVERTY




HOUSEHOLD INCOME INDEX (2008=100)
