Introduction

The Pact for Skills is a shared engagement and approach to skills development. It is firmly anchored in the principles of the [European Pillar of Social Rights](#) and supports the goals of the [Green Deal](#) and the [digital transformation](#), as set out in the Commission communication "[A strong Social Europe for Just Transitions](#)".

The Pact aims to mobilise and incentivise private and public stakeholders to take concrete action for the **up skilling and reskilling of people of working age**, and, when relevant, pool efforts in the partnerships.

Joining the Pact:

1. All stakeholders joining the Pact **sign up to the Charter** and its key principles, which they agree to respect and uphold.
2. Signatories of the Pact are invited to **translate their engagement into concrete commitments** on upskilling and reskilling. Commitments must be in line with the key principles and can be built around a number of "enablers" that illustrate concrete ways of implementing the different principles.
3. Commitments are monitored by at least one **key performance indicator**, e.g. number of people taking part in upskilling or reskilling.

The Centre for Entrepreneurship Education and Innovation at Schools (eesi-Impulsecentre) promotes the entrepreneurial spirit in all subjects in VET schools. The eesi-impulscentre certifies VET-business schools on either basic or advanced level, if they meet the requirements determined by the Centre. For the basic level 20 criteria and for the advanced level 30 are to be fulfilled. The criteria aim on improving students' entrepreneurial skills and teacher upskilling. Certified VET schools promote professional skills above average as well personal entrepreneurial competences like taking individual responsibility, showing maturity and solidarity in all actions. At the moment there are 62 Austrian VET schools certified, 39 in a re-certification process. Together with our partners we provide seminars for teachers and students and networking meetings. The Entrepreneurship Summit, a partner of the European Entrepreneurship Week, is the annual highlight, this year 1658 participants in 2 days.
