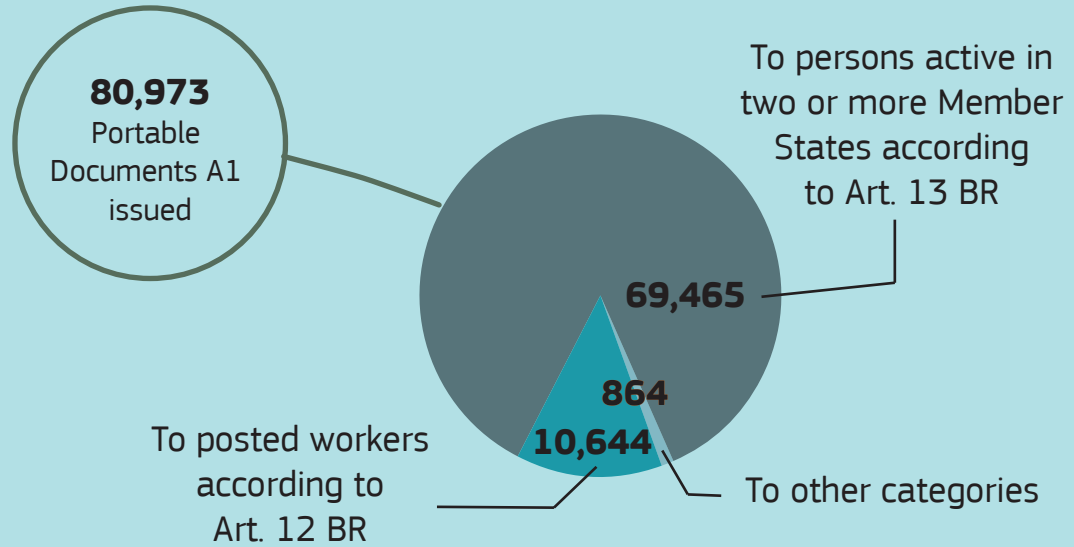

Pensions

Cross-border healthcare

86,580 pensions paid to beneficiaries who reside in another Member State

2.9% of the beneficiaries reside in another Member State

€ 174 million paid to beneficiaries who reside in another Member State

1.1% of total expenditure paid to beneficiaries who reside in another Member State

10 million EHIC's in circulation

Unplanned necessary cross-border healthcare

94.8% of the Czech population has an EHIC

168 persons received planned healthcare in another Member State on the basis of a Portable Document S2

Planned cross-border healthcare

86,715 persons are insured in the Czech Republic and reside in another Member State

130,098 persons reside in the Czech Republic and are insured in another Member State

Healthcare provided to persons residing in a Member State other than the competent one

Family benefits

Unemployment

519 family benefits paid to households who reside in another Member State

0.2% of the households entitled to a family benefit reside in another Member State

€ 1,070,703 family benefits paid to households who reside in another Member State

0.1% of total family benefits paid to households who reside in another Member State

269 authorisations issued to export the unemployment benefit to another Member State

0.3% of unemployed persons exported their unemployment benefit to another Member State

1,048 certificates proving periods of insurance or (self-)employment completed in other Member States taken into account for the acquisition of an unemployment benefit

0.9% of unemployed persons needed aggregated periods
