Second phase consultation of the social partners under Article 154 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, on the protection of workers from risks related to exposure to chemical agents at work and to asbestos at work

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

Following the EU social partners' responses to the first phase consultation launched on 17 December 2020, concerning the possible revisions of Chemical Agents Directive as well as the Asbestos at Work Directive, the Commission has identified possible avenues for EU action. In this context, the Commission is now launching a second-phase consultation of European social partners, in accordance with Article 154(3) TFEU.

The goal of the second-phase consultation is to discuss the possible content of, and relevant EU instruments for, the envisaged Commission proposal. The consultation also asks social partners whether they wish to enter into negotiations as provided for by Article 154(4) TFEU.

You will find the consultation document attached describing the content of the envisaged Commission proposal.
