Subject: Developing and exploiting links between transition research and employment and social policy: Information, discussion and training sessions

1. PURPOSE OF THE REQUEST FOR SERVICES

DG Employment, Social Affairs & Inclusion (DG EMPL) co-chairs Cluster 2 “Culture, Creative and Inclusive Society” of the framework research programme Horizon Europe (2021-2027). Research under this cluster aims, among others, at promoting socio-economic transformations that contribute to inclusion and growth, and hence needs to examine particularly the inclusiveness of the digital and green transitions.

To foster internal brainstorming and capacity-building on how to strengthen SSH integration and mainstreaming of employment and social aspects in R&I for fair green and digital transitions, DG EMPL aims to organise and conduct for its staff a series of multi-disciplinary high-quality seminars consisting of twelve 90-minutes sessions (online and, if possible, in Commission premises). The topics and adequate format of the sessions as well as the high quality speakers should be proposed by the contractor.

2. PRICE

The maximum amount for this contract is EUR 30 000.

3. INDICATIVE TIME SCHEDULE AND CONTACT POINT

The indicative time schedule for launching the negotiated procedure is mid-February 2022. Interested economic operators can express their interest to participate in this negotiated procedure until 1 March 2022, 17h Brussels time, in writing to EMPL-HORIZON-EUROPE@ec.europa.eu. The indicative date to sign the contract is mid-May 2022. The estimated performance period of the resulting contract is 8 months after the start of the contract.
