Annex 1: Footnotes

- 1. The 5th version of the questionnaire was sent out to Advisors for European PES Affairs (Afepas) on 31 October 2022. During the period until 30 November 2022 31 PES responded. PES mentioned in this compilation are examples, and therefore not comprehensive.
- 2. The questionnaire was sent to the Public Employment Services (PES) of all the 27 EU Member States as well as Norway and Iceland and Liechtenstein.
- 3. What are the latest figures of the number of displaced people from Ukraine registered at your PES? Please note A rough estimate based on information from 27 PES (AT, BE Actiris, BE Le Forem, BE VDAB, BG, CZ, HR, CY, DK, EE, FI, FR, DE, HU, IE, IS, IT, LT, LU, NO, PL, PT, RO, SK, SL, ES, SE). The cut-off date of the data varies somewhat across the PES, and for CY and RO the exact cut-off date is not specified.
- 4. What are the latest figures of the number of displaced people from Ukraine registered at your PES? Please note that the figures should be interpreted with caution because of some differences in reporting.
- 5. A rough estimate based on information from 21 PES (AT, BE Actiris, BG, CZ, HR, DK, EE, FI, FR, DE, IE, IS, LT, MT, NL, NO, PL, PT, RO, SK).
- 6. The figures reported by some countries may include both Ukrainian citizens with and without temporary protection (for instance in Poland that reported 678000 people in employment).
