What is the European Digital Skills Certificate?

The European Digital Skills Certificate (EDSC) will be a **tool to help people get their digital skills recognised across Europe** by employers, governments, training providers, and more. The EDSC will be based on the European Digital Competence Framework (DigComp) and is a concrete action of the Digital Education Action Plan.



What are the objectives?

- ✔ Enhancing recognition of digital skills through minimum quality requirements
- ✔ Complementing existing digital skills certifications
- ✔ Allowing people to indicate their level of digital skills
- ✔ Encouraging people to acquire new digital skills

The EDSC pilot

As part of the Digital Education and Skills Package and as a deliverable of the European Year of Skills, today, **the Commission is launching a pilot with several Member States**. Finland, Spain, Austria and Romania have expressed their interest to participate. **The pilot will test the practical use of an EDSC** in work, education and training.

- ➔ The results of the pilot will be presented as part of a feasibility study on the EDSC towards year-end.
- ➔ The final European Digital Skills Certificate will be rolled out in 2024, based on the pilot and the study.
