LESSONS LEARNT / GOOD PRACTICES

- Value of counselling / guidance provided already during the notice period.
- Implementation period was not long enough for several planned measures, including the preparation of business start-ups.
- Training some 400 participants for new jobs with a future is a significant benefit not only for the workers themselves, but also for the region as a whole, which is remote and threatened with depopulation.
- The Perlos measures have enabled the North Karelia authorities to draw up contingency plans for any future large-scale redundancies.
- Development and maintenance of a broad network of stakeholders is helpful for the support of the redundant workers and their rapid reintegration into employment.
- Early collaboration with the Commission meant that a more ambitious package of measures could be designed for the workers, than would otherwise have been possible, with a reasonable degree of assurance that it could be implemented through EGF help.
- Some innovative ideas could not be implemented as a result of national legislation which made no allowance for them.
- The final report contains an analysis of strengths and weaknesses, threats and opportunities encountered in this case, which may be helpful in planning other cases too.
