Our adjustments for EUDR this year



We have fast-tracked a number of key adjustments to our certification systems and tools.

These updates—made this year—will help us support EUDR needs in the following areas:

- **For farmers:** EUDR criteria for cocoa and coffee Certificate Holders
 - ▶ from January 15, 2024
- **For companies:** Supporting evidence for compliance

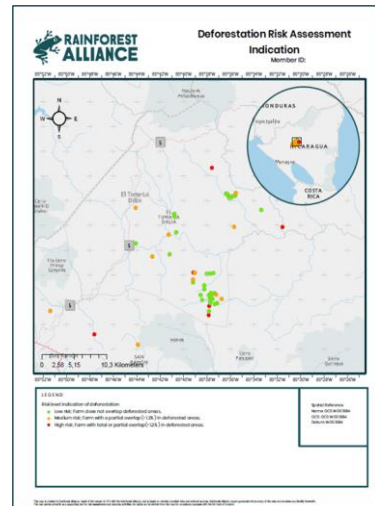

Since January 15, 2024, farmers can select specific criteria that align with EUDR requirements in the Rainforest Alliance Certification Platform (RACP).



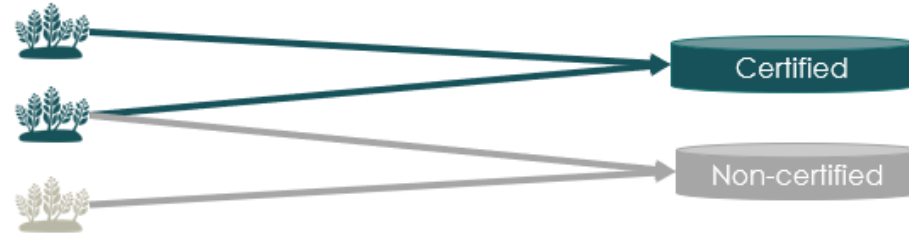

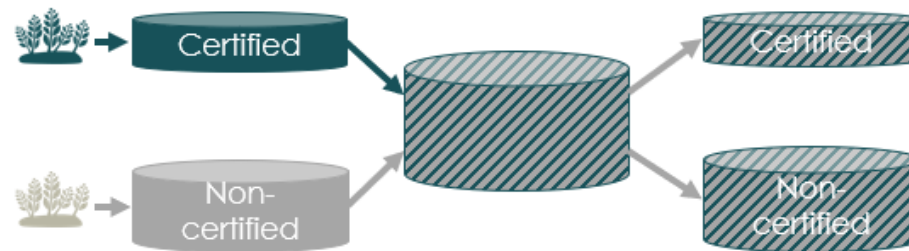

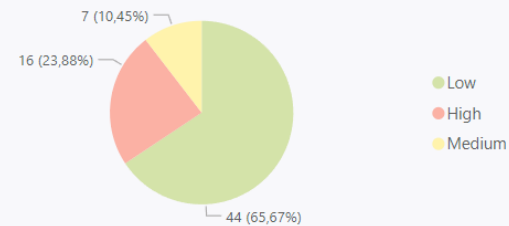

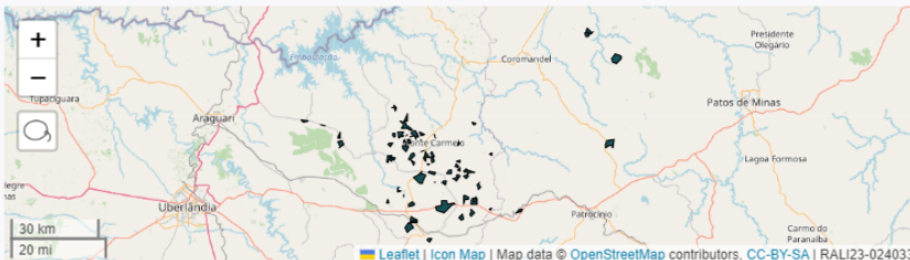

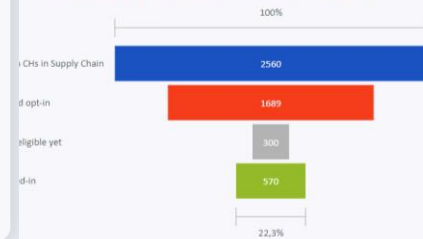

Number of Farm CHs in current* supply chain by EUDR status




Total cumulative number of Farm CHs by EUDR status
