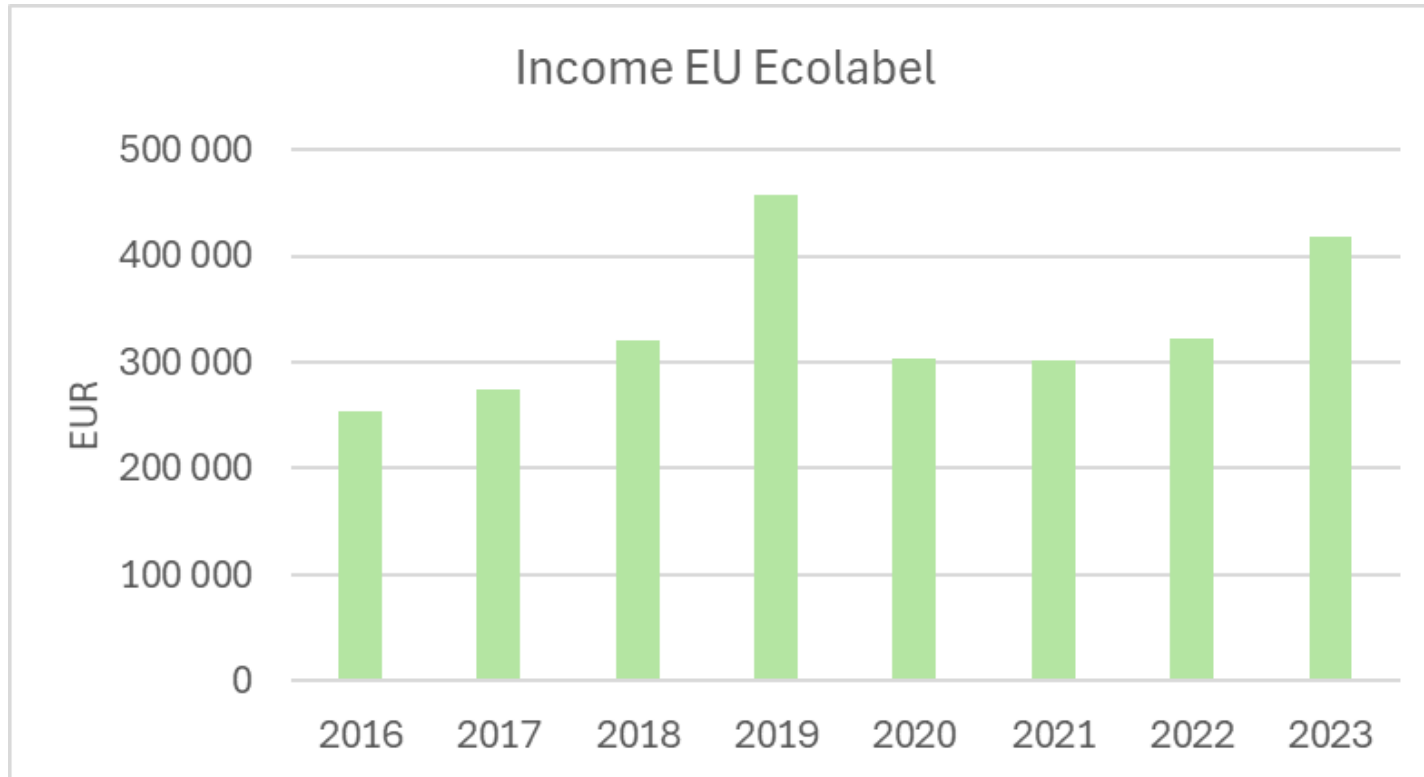

Current fees

- Application fee
 - 2 000 EUR (maximum according to Annex III)
 - Reductions apply for SME and micro companies
- Annual fee
 - 0,15 % of annual sales value (maximum according to Annex III)
 - Min 2 000 EUR
 - Max 25 000 EUR (maximum according to Annex III, corresponding to an annual sales value of ca 1 450 000 EUR)
 - Reductions apply for SME and micro companies

Income EU Ecolabel



- Income vary considerably over time
- Governmental support: ca 3,5 % of the total income for EU Ecolabel (year 2023)
- Costs also vary over time, especially due to renewals
- Approximate loss 175 000 EUR (year 2023)

We need to raise the fee levels

- Application fee
 - 2 000 EUR → 3 000 EUR
 - Reductions apply for SME and micro companies
- Annual fee
 - Max 25 000 EUR → max 100 000 EUR
 - Reductions apply for SME and micro companies
 - CBs decide their individual fee levels
 - Percentage rates can be differentiated between fee intervals

Are the suggested fees affordable?

- Annual fee in relation to annual sales value of the licence products (EEA, year 2023)
 - Total annual sales value: 2 400 million EUR
 - Total annual fees: 347 000 EUR
 - 0,015 % of the annual sales value (compared to the maximum percentage 0,15 % in Annex III)

What are the fees needed for?

- EU Ecolabel Regulation: fees to cover the costs of running the scheme
- Quality and trustworthiness of CBs work
- Development foreseen as a result of Green Deal initiatives
