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VUC - adult education center

In Denmark adult education programmes are offered at Adult Education Centres

- in short: VUC.

There are 29 VUCs spread geographically throughout the country



VUC since 2007

- self-governing institutions
- financed by the Danish state via taximeter funding
- The Ministry of Education issues the legislative framework according to which the adult education centres work
- It is obligatory to use ICT in the daily work

Teachers need to be educated

On diploma level:

- Courses for literacy
- Courses for math
- Courses for dysleksia
- ICT is a part of the education



Teacher education

Training of employed teachers:

- Is decentralized
- Special training in ITC in networks
- In conferences
- In special courses offered by the trade union
- Selftraining



QPDG – principles:

- Quiet room
- Presentation room
- Dialogue room
- Group rooms



Quiet room:

- immersion
- reflection
- withdraw and concentrate
- own learning



Presentation room:

- gathering function
- common focus
- review, presentation, explanation



Dialogue room, from the outside



Dialogue room:

- horizontal teacher role
- contact at eye level
- focus on product instead of teacher
- sharing and showing products



Group room:

- working crosswise
- use of the subject knowledge
- active course work
