During the 19th CLEN Plenary meeting in February 2017, it was confirmed that a third proficiency test on mineral oils and second study on aromatics in mineral oils should be organised.

The aim of this proficiency test is to meet the needs of Customs Laboratories regarding analytical determinations on mineral oil products, taking into account suggestions from the previous tests and from the Project Group on HS/CN chemical chapters.

The proficiency test will concentrate on parameters or products for which there is no commercial proficiency test available.

The study on aromatics will include working with the methods in Annex A of Chapter 27 (estimating precision data) and trying to find effective, simple and reproducible analytical method(s) to determine aromatic constituents.

This meeting will aim at defining the proficiency test and study: choice of matrices, parameters, analytical methods, presentation of the results, etc.

Please note that **the meeting will take place at the Central Management of the National Tax and Customs Administration, Budapest, 1054 Széchenyi utca 2., on 20-21 April 2017 (09:00 -17:30 on 20 April and 09:00 -16:00 on 21 April)**. The meeting will be held in English.

The group is composed of volunteer Customs Laboratories.

One delegate per invited Member State (in addition to the Hungarian coordinator and to the French Action 2 Leader) **can be reimbursed from the Customs 2020 budget** under the conditions specified in the financial guide.

The financial code is CPG/010/015.

The delegates should **confirm their participation by 3 April 2017** at the latest, to CLEN-TAS@eurofins.com, gyani.zsofia@nav.gov.hu and kapillerne.rita@nav.gov.hu.

In addition, National Coordinators are requested to register their participants in the Activity Reporting Tool by the same deadline.

Delegates should contact their Customs 2020 National Coordinator before making any travel arrangements.

Officials attending events organized under the programmes have to **respect the reporting obligation** under the Performance Measurement Framework (PMF) of the programme by providing feedback through **Event Assessment Forms** when requested. Programme Coordinators should encourage participants to respect this obligation

Note: Russia and Moldova are welcome to send an expert delegate. However their expenses will not be covered by the Customs 2020 budget.
