Selection Procedure (members)

Members are selected following the continuously open "Call addressed to individuals for the establishment of a database of prospective independent experts to assist Commission services with tasks in connection with Horizon 2020 – the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation". Following criteria are taken into account: - Proven competence and experience, including at European and/or international level, in the field of security policy and research, - proven competence and experience in horizontal expertise, including cross-cutting issues of relevance for Horizon 2020. The composition of the group takes into account the need to ensure balanced participation in terms of representativeness of stakeholders (e.g. end-users, researchers, public authorities and industry representatives), gender, age and geographical origin (without calling into question the necessary level of expertise and insight).
