these expert group operates in an informal setting without any formal rules of procedures. The European Commission organizes and chairs the meetings.

Other

According to the Copenhagen process, which aims to improve the performance, quality and attractiveness of vocational education and training (VET), Vet providers have a key role in building partnerships with authorities and companies, in addition, several policy deliverables to which the EU and Member States committed themselves in the Bruges Communiqué call for commitment by and cooperation with VET providers. The Riga conclusions endorsed by Member States, candidate countries and European Social Partners also highlight the importance of cooperation with VET providers.
