The support provided in the form of an e-card allows families the flexibility and autonomy to have cash in hand to buy the fresh food that they need. As the funds are spent in Lebanese shops, the programme is providing a significant injection of cash into the Lebanese economy. Shakhwan can now easily move around, thanks to a ramp that was built outside his house, and help his wife with the two cows they were given so that the

family can start their own dairy production. This QUDRA project is an initiative supporting Peshmerga who were injured fighting the so-called IS and is co-financed by the EU Trust Fund in Response to the Syrian Crisis and implemented by GIZ, AECID and EF. Nearly 600,000 Syrians and local community members are benefiting from the QUDRA project in Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey, which helps them become more resilient and part of a cohesive society.
