Provide better access to quality education and livelihood opportunities to children, youth, and adults.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- Provide education and psychosocial support programmes, transportation, safety at schools, access to libraries and social activities.
- Provide school-aged Syrians with access to vocational high schools, Turkish language courses, support teachers and incentives.
- Provide Language courses for adults, as well as certified vocational training, transportation and formal job opportunities.

HOW DO WE WORK?

WITH CHILDREN

- Recruit and train community outreach team;
- Provide information to community outreach teams so they share information about access to education opportunities;
- Identify Public Education Centres (PECs);
- Hire informal education staff;
- Make teaching and learning materials available;
- Implement education support programmes, Turkish language classes and catch-up classes;
- Identify transportation service providers;
- Organise daily transportation to and from PECs;
- Identify locations for libraries in camps;
- Make library books available;
- Rehabilitate/build library spaces in camps;
- Hold social events.
- Implement Turkish language training;
- Support families to enrol youth in vocational high schools;
- Provide one-off 'back to school' financial support;
- Identify teachers to participate in ongoing professional development activities;
- Organise and implement teacher training.

WITH ADULTS

WITH YOUTH

- Identify vocational high schools;
- Implement construction and installation of relevant equipment;
- Identify youth to enrol in vocational high schools;
- Identify Syrian adults to receive Turkish language courses;
- Identify vulnerable Syrian and Turkish adults;
- Identify vocational high schools to host vocational training for adults;
- Implement vocational training courses;
- Establish system for tracking attendance;
- Conduct career mentoring and life skills training with students;
- Match vocational training participants to job placement hosts;
- Translate certificates and degrees.
