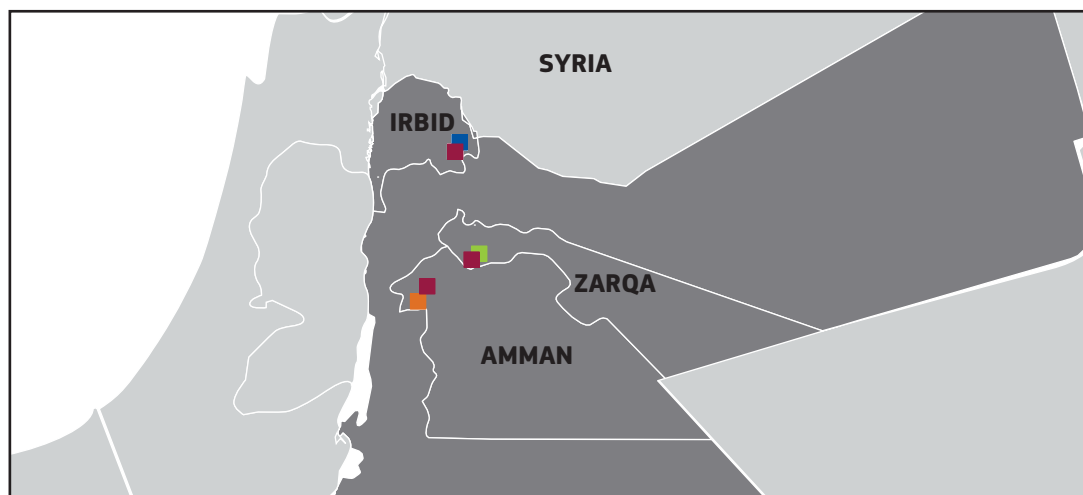

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES - IFTAR



On Tuesday 20 June 2017, on World Refugee Day, the Edu-Syria programme, managed by the German Jordanian University and funded by the EU Regional Trust Fund in Response to the Syrian Crisis, organised an Iftar banquet for 250 students affiliated with the programme, 50 of which live in the Al Zaatari camp.

The Iftar was held at Zarqa University in the presence of the Trust Fund team, representatives of the EU Delegation to Jordan and the project management team from the German Jordanian University (GJU).
